


#### TITLE

Sermon Text

Psalm 119:9-16



<sup>9</sup> How can a young person stay on the path of purity? By living according to your word. <sup>10</sup> I seek you with all my heart; do not let me stray from your commands. <sup>11</sup> I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. <sup>12</sup> Praise be to you, Lord; teach me your decrees.

<sup>13</sup> With my lips I recount all the laws that come from your mouth. <sup>14</sup> I rejoice in following your statutes as one rejoices in great riches. <sup>15</sup> I meditate on your precepts and consider your ways. <sup>16</sup> I delight in your decrees; I will not neglect your word



### **Heart** (Bible word *Levav*)

In general, it means the ruling center of the human life

1 Sam 25:37


Emotion

#### Soul (Nephesh)

- Bible word differs from English word
- English word translates to the inner being that lives on after we die.
- Throat physical thirst (Egypt). Spiritual thirst (Psalm 42).
- The whole being Acts 27


#### The soul looks something like this



#### **Spiritual Transformation Process**

Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God – this is your true and proper worship. Do not conform to the patterns of this world, but be <u>transformed by the renewing of your mind</u>. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is – his good, pleasing and perfect will.
