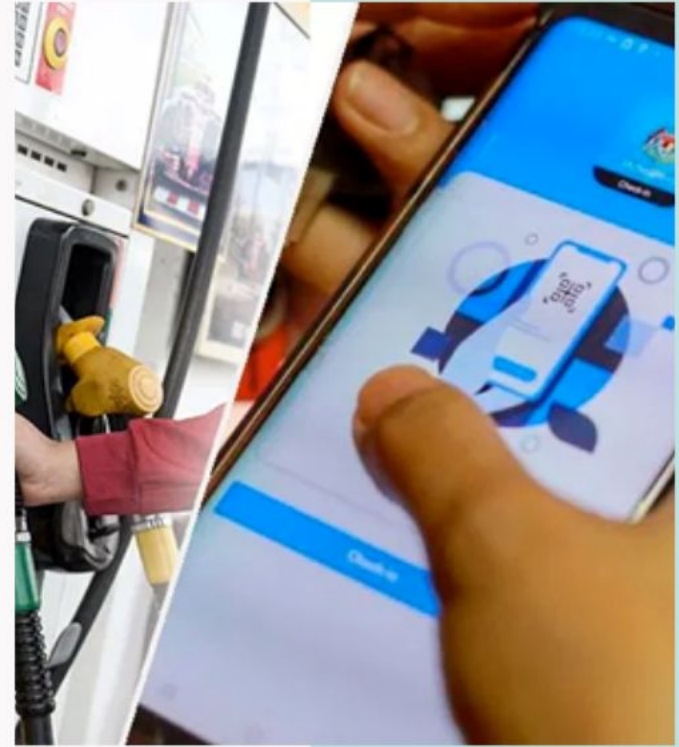



# Gloom & Doom





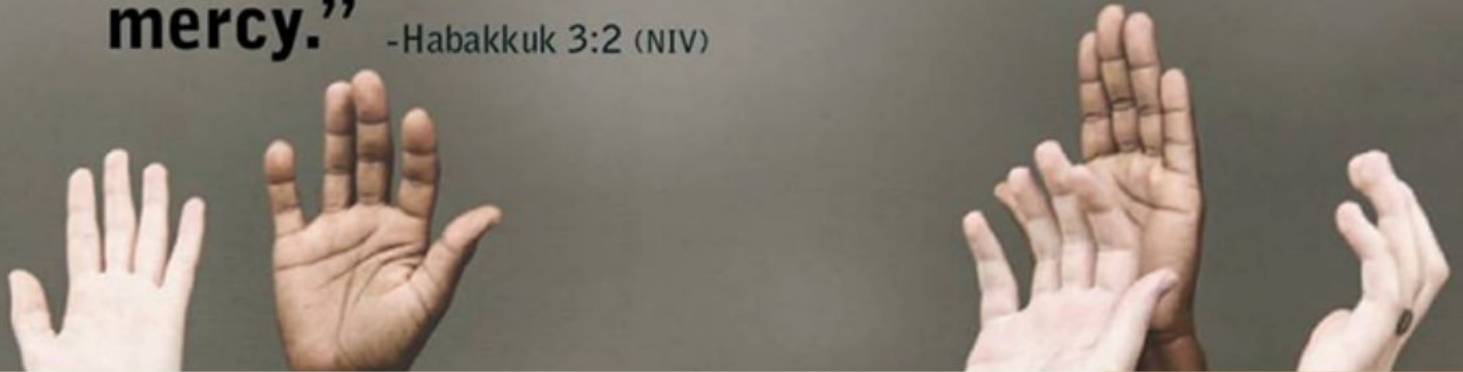



—what power hidden in that fist!







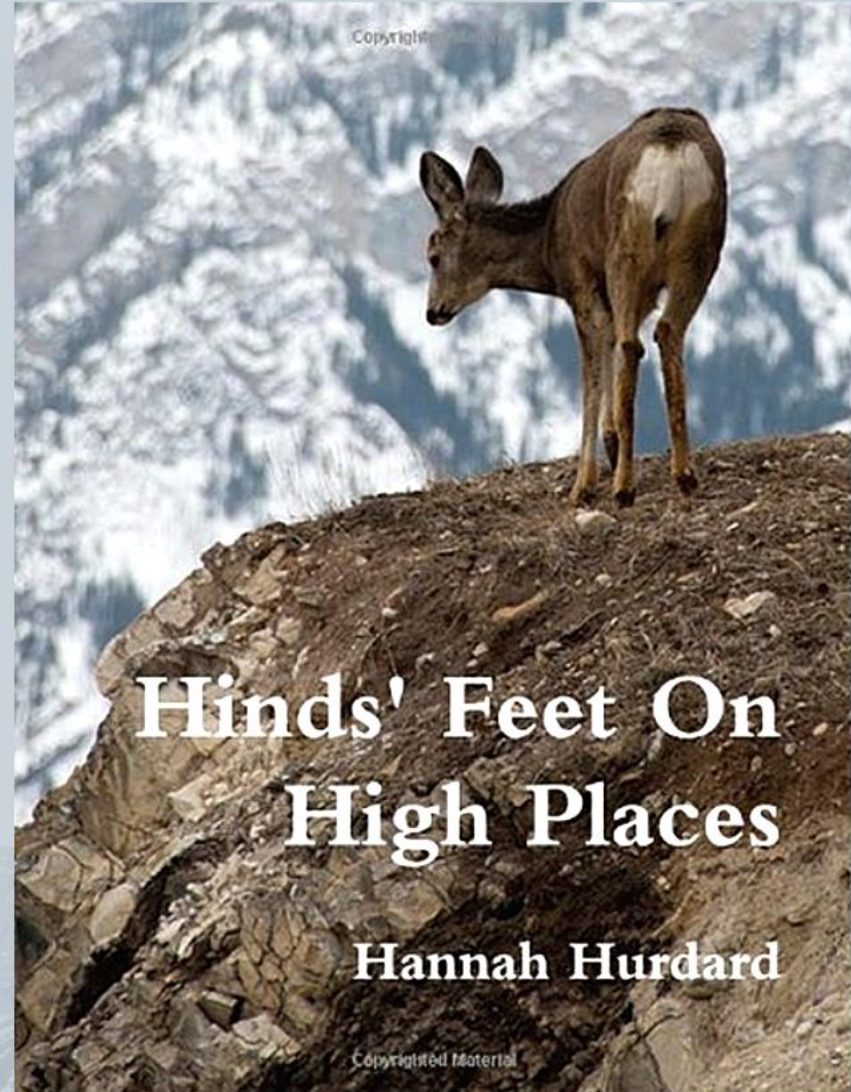
