## READ: Matthew 16:21-27 CJB

From that time or, Yeshua began making it clear to his *talmidim* that he had to go to Yerushalayim and endure much suffering at the hands of the elders, the head *cohanim* and the *Torah*-teachers; and that he had to be put to death; but that on the third day, he had to be raised to life.

#### I REFLECT PURPOSEFULLY

Matthew 16:21, 17:22f, CJB

16:21 From that time on, Yeshua began making it clear to his *talmidim* that he had to go to Yerushalayim and endure much suffering at the hands of the elders, the head *cohanim* and the *Torah*-teachers; and that he had to be put to death; but that on the third day, he had to be raised to life (Matt. 16:21).

<sup>17:22</sup> As they were going about together in the Galil, Yeshua said to them, "The Son of Man is about to be betrayed into the hands of people <sup>23</sup> who will put him to death, and on the third day he will be raised." And they were filled with sadness (Matt. 17:22-23).

<sup>26:1</sup> When Yeshua had finished speaking, he said to his *talmidim*, <sup>2</sup> "As you know, *Pesach* is two days away, and the Son of Man will be handed over to be nailed to the execution-stake" (Matt. 26:1)

## II REPENT (REROUTE) IMMEDIATELY Matthew 16:22-23 CJB




- <sup>22</sup> Kefa took him aside and began rebuking him, "Heaven be merciful, Lord! By no means will this happen to you!"




Continuously being aware of God's presence in everyday moments rather than about the past or the future.


#### Finding the Sacred in Everyday Life
