Kindness and compassion flow from <u>LOVE</u>

Will manifest kindness and compassion

Good relationships can be found in the church IN CHRIST

healing and reconciliation

Be kind and compassionate to one another

Addressed to the church
Meaning that the church needs to take note

Bitterness, Rage and Anger

Bitterness (pikrea) – resentment, spite, envious, acridity

Rage (thumos) – fierceness, wrath

Anger (orge) – indignation

Having bad feelings towards others

Don't like about the other person (why?)

Pointing finger

Criticizing and judging

Not accepting

You are wrong, I am right



Your Are Wrong, I Am Right

Brawling, Slander, Malice

Brawling (krauge) – clamor, outcry, shout Slander (blasphemia) – blasphemy, evil speaking Malice (kakia) – hate, malignity, wickedness

A higher level of bad relationships
Wanting to harm
Becoming aggressive, violent, and evil

Brawling, Slander, Malice

Wanting to bring down, kill and destroy Attacks, wars, terrorism, destruction

Killing with words
Speaking evil behind their backs
Bringing down reputation/life



Get Rid of All these Bad Feelings/Behaviors

Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. Eph 4:31-32

Get rid of (airo) – remove, take away [Imperative mood]

For they defile and contaminate

No place among us

Get rid of them today

Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. Eph 4:31-32

Instead, be kind and compassionate [Imperative mood]

Kind (chrestos Gal 5:22) – gentleness, goodness, gracious

Compassionate (eusplagchnos) – tender-hearted, sympathetic

Though the person is wrong or weak (fail)

Accepting (the weak and the wrong)

Reaching out – not distancing nor isolating

Eye contact, smiling, speaking, listening

Forgiving just as Christ forgives us (before the wrong asks)

Unoffending (to both ways)

No ill feelings

Non condemning

Denying and dying to self

Gentle and nice

Doing good

Showing love

Having patience



Some Examples

In the **family** – "Why you ..." (tone of voice, body language)

Among our **friends** – in the heart though nonverbalized (still unkind)

In the church

Leaders talk a lot and do a lot

Will make mistakes and be not good enough

Targets for criticism and attacks

Have we been kind and compassionate?

Do we appreciate those who have done some good?

Some are scared to be leaders – not good enough

If you are a leader, you must be willing to be criticized

We can criticize - with kindness, compassion, and love

Desire and will to be kind and compassionate

Think good thoughts towards imperfect people

Do not wish for bad and harm to happen to others
