







MAJORITY CHRISTIAN DENOMINATION BY COUNTRY




CHRISTIAN POPULATION BY MAJOR TRADITIONS





Unreached People Groups




COUNTRIES WITH MOST UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS

Coca Cola

- *Mary's story illustrates the remarkable capacity of business to reach people virtually anywhere in the world, including places where the gospel still struggles to gain a foothold.





















