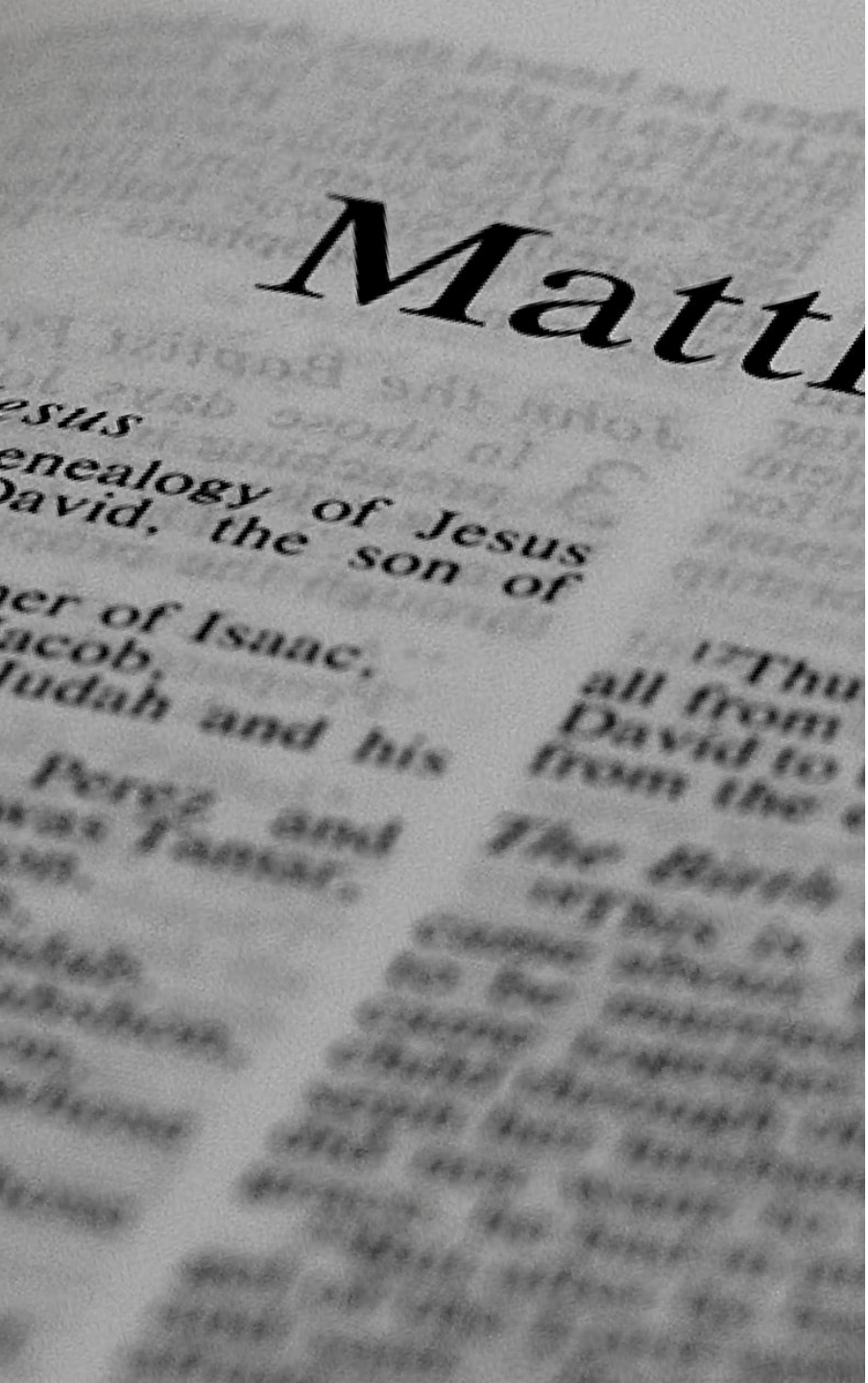

Genesis 2:4 “This is **the account of the heavens and the earth** when they were created, when the Lord God made the earth and the heavens.”

Genesis 5:1 “This is **the written account of Adam's family line.**”

## GOD'S UNCHANGING PLAN

Genesis 5:1 “This is the written account of Adam’s family line.

When God created mankind, he made them in the likeness of God. 2 He created them male and female and blessed them. And he named them “Mankind” when they were created...

5 Altogether Adam lived a total of 930 years, **and then he died...**

8 Altogether, Seth lived a total of 912 years, and **then he died...**

11 Enosh lived a total of 905 years, **and then he died...**

14 Kenan lived a total of 910 years, and **then he died...**

17 Altogether, Mahalalel lived a total of 895 years, **and then he died....**

32 After Noah was 500 years old, he became the father of Shem, Ham and Japheth.

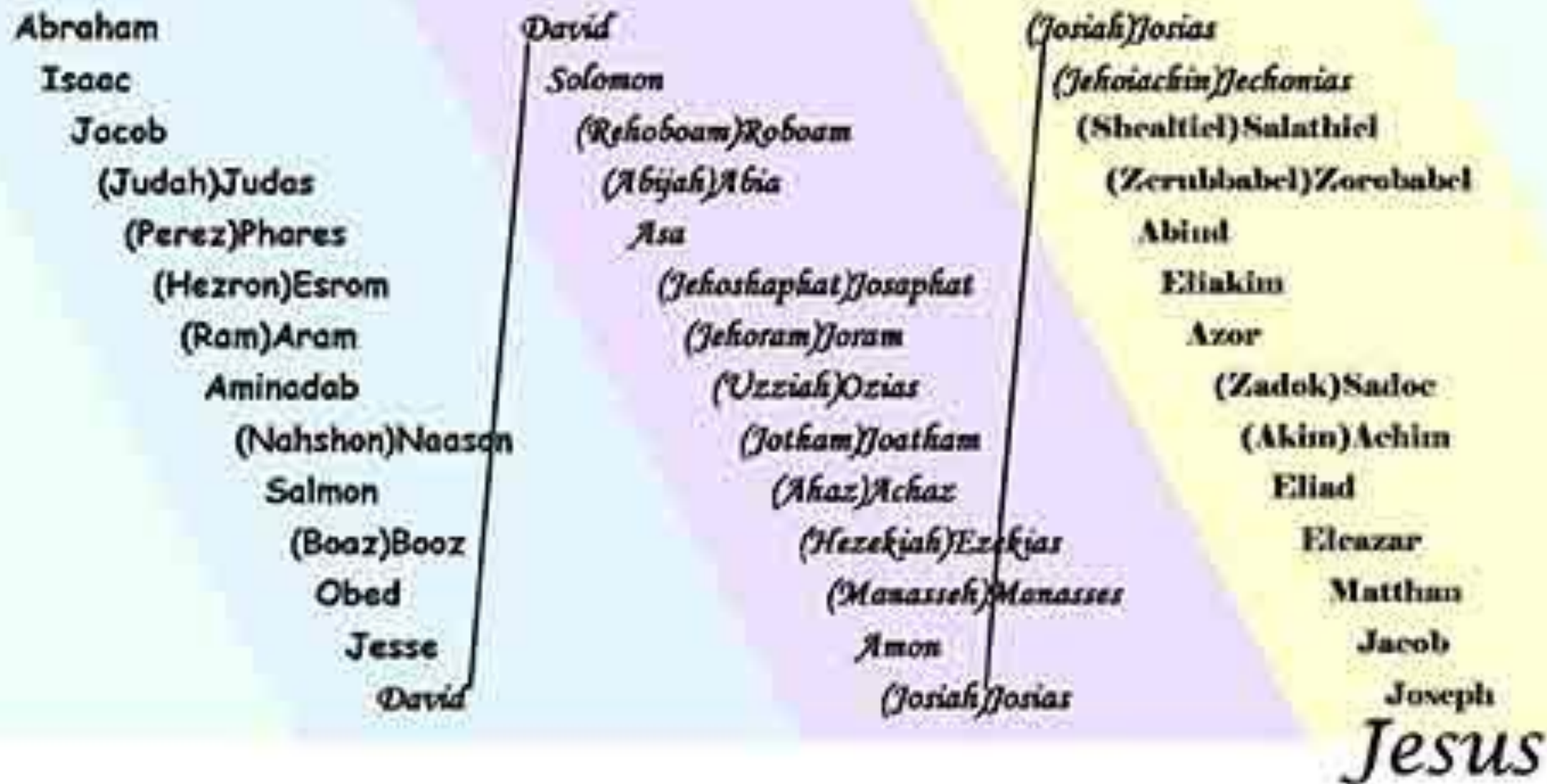

Jesus' 2<sup>nd</sup> coming –

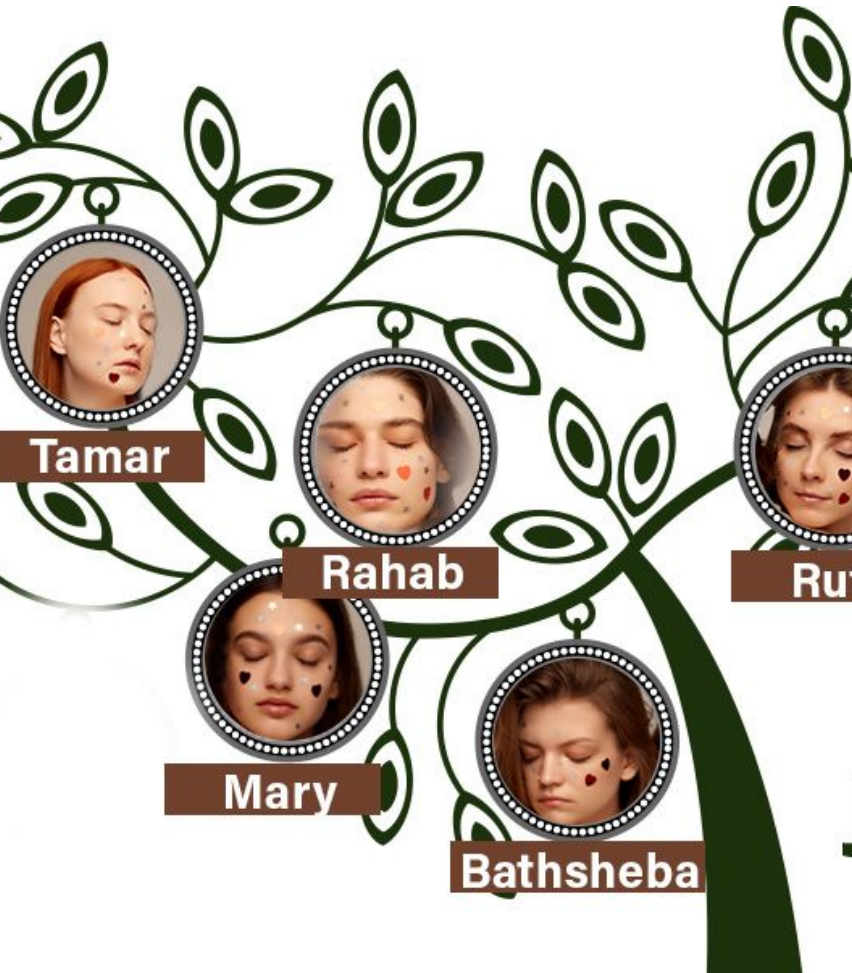
