# Joshua 1:1-11

**1** After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, the LORD said to Joshua son of Nun, Moses' aide: **2** "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites. **3** I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses. **4** Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Mediterranean Sea in the west. **5** No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you. **6** Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them.

<sup>7</sup> “Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. <sup>8</sup> Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. <sup>9</sup> Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go.”

<sup>10</sup> So Joshua ordered the officers of the people: <sup>11</sup> “Go through the camp and tell the people, ‘Get your provisions ready. Three days from now you will cross the Jordan here to go in and take possession of the land the LORD your God is giving you for your own.’”

## 4 Key Themes “P”s

1. **PHASE** (v.1-2):  
Recognizing God’s **Timing**.
2. **PROMISE** (v.3-6):  
Claiming **Land** and **Presence**.
3. **PURSUE** (v.7-9):  
Moving forward with **Grit & Grounded in Scripture**.
4. **POSSESS** (v.10-11):  
Seizing our **Inheritance**.

# 1. PHASE - Recognizing God's Timing

- God works through divine timelines and appointed seasons (Ecclesiastes 3:1)
- Israel's transition: From waiting to crossing over
- Leadership shift: Moses to Joshua
- What does our new season look like?

## **2. PROMISE - Claiming Land and Presence**

- God's pledge: "I will give you every place where you set your foot"
- Vast territory promised (about 40x size of modern Singapore)
- God's presence: "I will never leave you nor forsake you"
- Strength comes from God's presence, not military power

### **3. PURSUE – Moving with Grit, Grounded in the Word**

- Stance: Boldness and courage
- Leadership style: Decisive and directive (Joshua vs. Moses)
- Grounded in God's Word: Meditate day and night
- Christian meditation: Filling minds with God's truth

## **4. POSSESS – Seizing Our Inheritance**

- “Go in and take possession” – Divine urgency
- Be ready to step in when God opens the door
- FPBC’s time to claim the promise

- One word sums up our journey ahead: **INTENSE**.
