Carry the Fire, Entrust the Future

2 Timothy 2:2



2 TIMOTHY 2:1-7

You then, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. ² And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others. ³ Join with me in suffering, like a good soldier of Christ Jesus. ⁴ No one serving as a soldier gets entangled in civilian affairs, but rather tries to please his commanding officer. ⁵ Similarly, anyone who competes as an athlete does not receive the victor's crown except by competing according to the rules. ⁶ The hardworking farmer should be the first to receive a share of the crops. ⁷ Reflect on what I am saying, for the Lord will give you insight into all this.

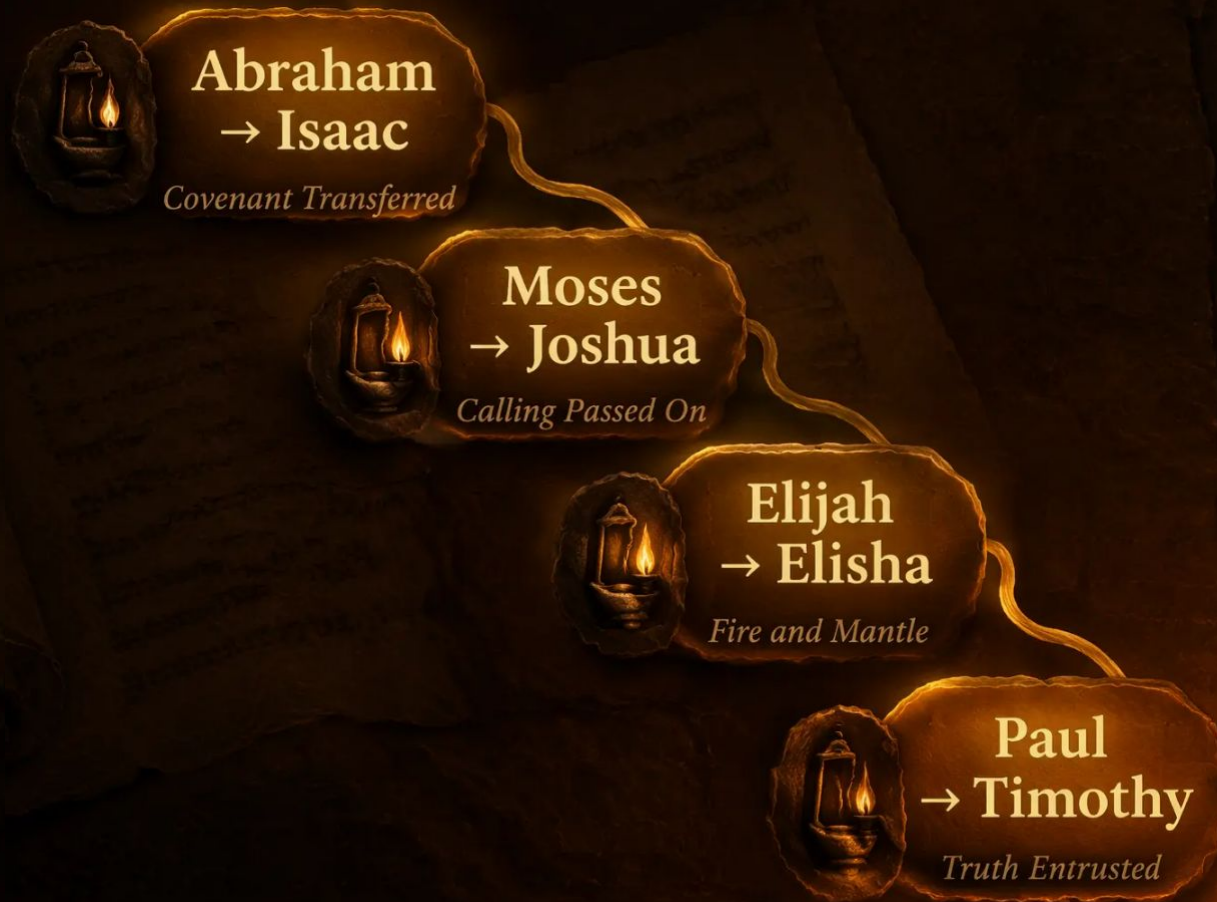

Season of Stewardship

From Age to Assignment

Your experience is not a résumé. It is a resource.

Sound Doctrine

The truth that anchors every generation



Prayer Life

A living conversation with the living God



Spiritual Disciplines

Fasting, worship, Scripture, and solitude



Testimonies of Faithfulness

Proof that God is faithful. Share your story



Love for His Presence

Hunger that cannot be taught, only caught

Kingdom Leadership Principle

Invest in People Like the Future Depends on It

Truth: We teach what we know, but we reproduce who we are

In the Kingdom, it does.

- Do not only fill roles; form people.
- Do not only run ministries; raise sons and daughters.
- Do not only correct; call out their potential.

Discernment in Discipleship

Find the Faithful, Not Just the Flashy

Look past the polished and prominent. Seek the hungry, the teachable, the consistent — those who show up when no one is watching.



Hunger

A deep desire for God
that cannot be faked



Teachability

Willing to receive
correction and grow



Consistency

Faithful in small things
over time



Humility

Serves without needing
the spotlight



Availability

Present, willing,
and not self-protected



Love

For God, for people,
for the Word

Carry the Fire

Carry the Fire, Not Just the File

The File

— information, doctrine, tradition.



Doctrine alone preserves truth

The Fire

— transformation, encounter, the Holy Spirit.



The Spirit transforms lives

Pass on both – the Word and the Fire.

Christianity is not merely information. it is transformation through divine encounter.

How Fire Is Passed

How Fire Is Passed

Fire is not downloaded. It is caught through closeness.



1. Proximity

Stay close; let them watch you live.



2. Prayer

Intercede for them by name, consistently.



3. Modeling

Show them what faithfulness looks like in ordinary days.



4. Testimony

Share where God has been faithful in your story.



5. Open Doors

Give them real opportunities to serve and lead.



6. Correction with Love

Speak truth as a father or mother, not a critic.

“The next generation needs fathers and mothers,
not only critics and spectators.”

When Fear Becomes the Wall

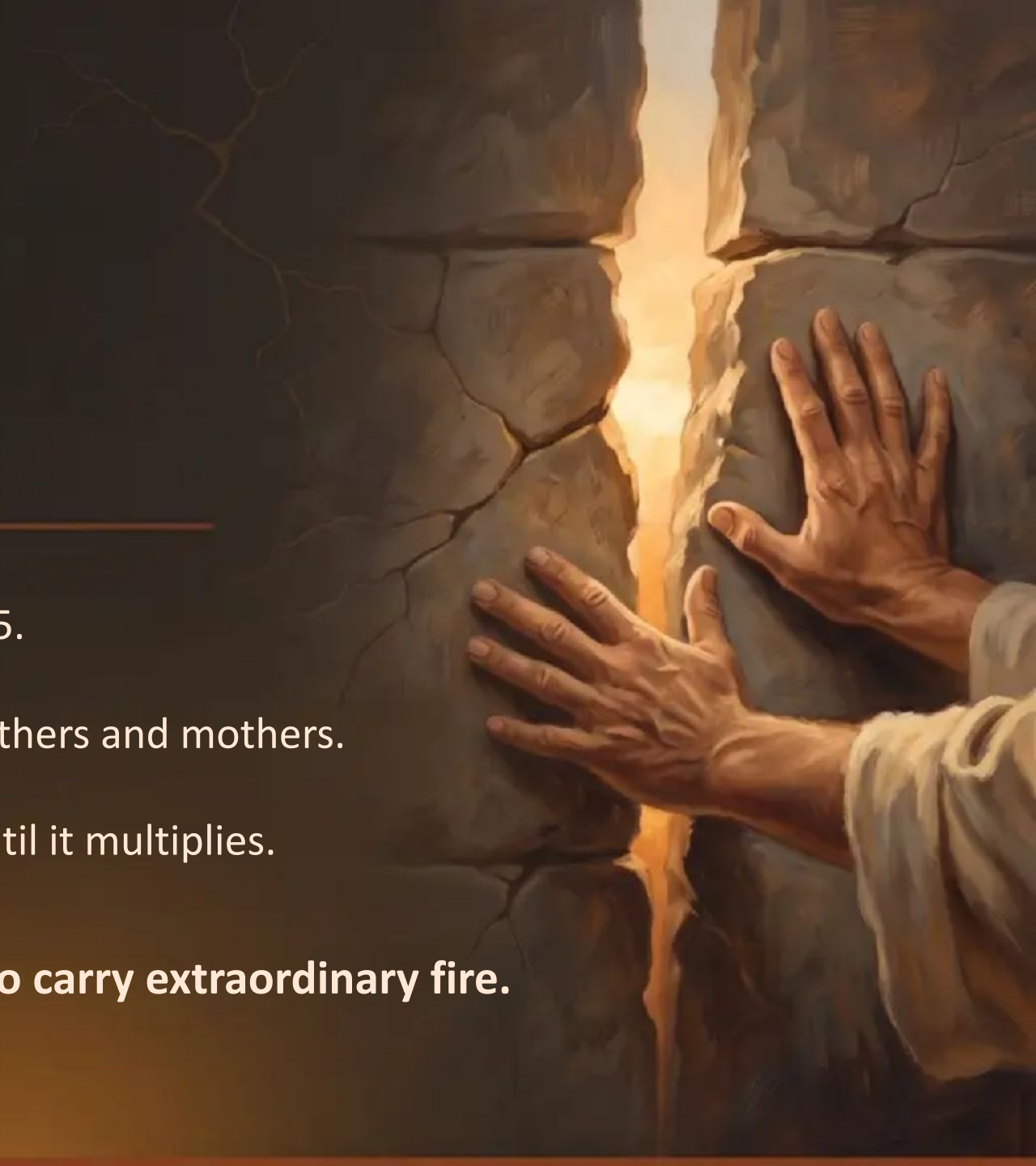
The Barriers We Must Break
